We read that in Deut. 16:12-15.

"And you shall remember that you were a slave in Egypt, and you shall be careful to observe these statutes.

"You shall observe the Feast of Tabernacles seven days, when you have gathered from your threshing floor and from your winepress;

"and you shall rejoice in your feast, you and your son and your daughter, your manservant and your maidservant and the Levite, the stranger and the fatherless and the widow, who are within your gates.

"Seven days you shall keep a sacred feast to the Lord your God in the place which the Lord chooses, because the Lord your God will bless you in all your produce and in all the work of your hands, so that you surely rejoice.

How is that possible with all of the problems we face? We have mounting challenges with the covid 19 pandemic and all of its ramifications. We have personal challenges health issues, financial issues, interpersonal problems. But God didn't tell us to rejoice when conditions are perfect, when we free of any difficulties and trials, when our health and our finances are doing well. Yahweh the Almighty God, God the Provider had through many miracles brought them to the very borders of the promised land but when the spies sent out to scout the land came back 10 of the 12 representatives of each of the tribes said we can't go in because there are giants in the land and we are like grasshoppers in their sight. We read in Hebrews that they did not enter that rest i.e. the Promised Land, a type of the Kingdom of God because of unbelief. It's hard to imagine how they forgot that God who had through many miracles brought them this far would also give them the victory over these formidable foe as long as they trusted in Him. Lack of faith kept them from the Promised Land they all died
