How did we come to the doctrine that we have today?

God Christ Apostles Disciples More Disciples Two ingredients that must be present in order for God's doctrine to be transmitted:

- Holy Spirit (Enabler)
- 2. Word of God (Food or Substance)
- Matt. 28:19-20 Christ sent His Apostles out to make disciples of the nations -- "teaching them. . . "
- II Tim. 2:1 "The things which you have heard of me, the same teach to others. . ."

There is one TRUE doctrine and it stems from God!

- Luke 10:22 "The Son (Christ) will reveal Him (God)."

 "All things have been delivered unto me by my Father."
- Assignment: 1. What is our duty in doctrine?
 - What is our responsibility to those who teach false doctrine?
 - 3. Who shall He (God) teach doctrine?

The first major topic will be the Godhead!

I Jn. 4:1-6 Try the spirits. "Many false prophecies or prophets have gone out into the world" so, try the doctrines or teachings. We must be tuned into the spirit of truth.

The Godhead

Who and what composes the Godhead? Can the Godhead be expanded?

Catholic and Protestant world limit the Godhead to 3 persons (making the Holy Spirit a personage).

Acts 17 Athens = Western Civilization derived from.

Paul was amongst the philosophers of the day on Mars

Hill.

vs. 29 The Godhead is not a graven image!

Godhead - "Theios" (Strong's 2304) That which is divine; talking about beings that transcend human beings.

Godhead - "Theiotes" (Strong's 2305) Eternal power Rom. 1:20

and Divineness.

Godhead - "Theiotes" (Strong's 2320) Divinity: All Col. 2:9 the fullness of the Godhead bodily. Christ was God

in the flesh and man.

Many accuse us of believing that Jesus was not both God and man. This is a lie. We do! We do however believe that Christ BECAME the Son of God once born of woman and resurrected as the first BORN of many brethren.

2 Pet. 1:4

"That we might be partakers of the divine (God) nature"! Divinity is simply another word for God. The divinity was in the body of Christ fully. Christ said, "He who has seen me has seen the Father" (directly contrary to gnostic belief).

Topics at hand -- next lecture -- God, Christ and Holy Spirit.

September 6, 1988 Lecture 3

Jn. 4:24 Composition of the "Godhead" consists of spirit.

Three levels of spirit:

- 1. God level of spirit-- Inherent life is in the members of the Godhead.
- Angelic level of spirit -- Angels are <u>not</u> in the Godhead.
- 3. Spirit in man level of spirit -- This comes from God through Christ (begotten sons and daugthers).
- Heb. 11:3 Things which are seen are made of things which do not appear. Both man and angels are created beings. Only man, however has the potential of becoming part of the Godhead. Having self-inherent life dwelling within us.

Physical Creation

Animal Vegetable Mineral

Jn. 5:19-24 The Father has life within Himself...

I Jn. 5:10 He that has the Son has life, he that not the Son, has not life.

God and Logos existed eternally without beginning of days nor end of days.

As a result of the Logos emptying Himself of His divinity and paying the penalty of our sins, we can be reconciled to God and receive eternal life.

As long as Christ was in the flesh, He had the potential of losing His self-inherent life.

Heb. 9:26,27 Dr. Ward does not believe that all of us someday will be saviors for other worlds in the future. Christ was <u>once</u> offered to bare the sins of many. (For all men for all ages).

I Jn. 3:10 Once you are born of God, you "cannot" sin. We will be born of God. Our potential to lose it then is impossible.

Also, based on the fact that angels are "created" beings (God brought them to being out of nothing) some have speculated that because angels are spirit they will live forever. Dr. Ward does not believe that the angels can not be rendered of non-effect.

The spirit essence of angels is <u>not</u> the self-inherent spirit life of the two present members of the Godhead (God and Christ).

I Tim. 6:15 "Whom only hath immortality" (referring to God and Christ)

Phil. 2:6 Christ (as the Logos) was in the form of God-- equal to God.

Rom. 8:9-11 The spirit is life because of righteousness.
"...raise you up by His spirit that is in us."
Even though Christ was without consciousness in the grave 3 days and 3 nights, He still had spirit life.

(Lengthy discussion ensued regarding angels and immortality)

II Thess. 2:8 Christ will destroy with the brightness of His coming.

Rev. 20:10 Devil shall be tormented day and night forever and ever. It appears from this that satan <u>is not</u> destroyed or vaporized into nothingness -- but is tormented forever!!

Those good angels will live forever. Their character is set. How or when it was set, we don't know.

Those fallen angels will be judged. Judgement has two phases:

- 1. a period of testing
- sentencing

James 4:12 The law is given to sustain life. Life, however does not come from the law. Life comes from God. All are subject to God's law.

God = Law = Love = Light = Life

Paul's salutations never include the Holy Spirit as a separate distinct entity.



Mystery of the Ages

5 reasons why Christ came:

- 1. To qualify where the first Adam failed
- 2. To Announce the Kingdom of God
- 3. To take on the role of savior
- 4. To be resurrected from the dead
- 5. To establish God's Church

THE HOLY SPIRIT

How do you receive it? Acts 2:38 Summary of Hebrews 6:1-2.

> True repentence that leads to surrender of whole being to God requires the Holy Spirit. A human repentence, like in Nineveh, can take place w/o the Holy Spirit.

> Godly repentence is an entire change of heart and mind.

Different Levels of Repentence:

First level Motiviation to change

Second level Recognizing it is a sin

Third level Seeing Sin is against God--It is easy to develop first two levels out of fear of "death" or fear of

things to come.

Fourth level Realizing God had every right to destroy you long ago but didn't out of mercy (Romans 2:4).

14 Works of the Holy Spirit

I Jn 5:11 Imparts Eternal Life (also: II Cor. 13:5).

The amount of submission and clossness to God determines how much of His Holy Spirit you will have working in you. Realize that everything you have to do is secondary to your relationship with God. Consistency is something you must become when you commit your life to God. (I Jn 4:12-13; Eph 3:14-20; Ps 37:4; Rm 8:9)

Ps 104:30 The Physical and Spiritual Creation. (also: Rm 5:3-5; Rm 4:22-23; Ps 51:10)

Jn 16:7-8 Convicts of sin--Elencho means convict. Convicting also means to lay on your mind what you should do.

Jn 16:8,10 Makes it possible to keep the commandments (Rm 13:10; Ps 119:172)

Jn 16:8,11 Gives you discernment and sound judgement
Three steps of developing judgment

1. Conviction

2. Period of time

3. Discernment

(Judgement must grow and develop)

Jn 16:13 Guides you into the truth (Isa 8:20; Jn 17:17)

II Fet 1:19 Shows things to come (also: Jn 16:13)

Jn 14:26 Teaches all things--requires action on your part.

Brings things to Rememberance--you must study and work at it yourself, then claim the promise.

I Cor 2:10-11 Allows understanding of Spiritual things (Eph 3:17-18)

Jn 6:44 Draws you to God

I Cor 12:12-14 Baptizes you into the body of Christ

I Cor 12:6-11 Imparts you the gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Phil 2:5 Imparts the character of God/mind of Christ (Rm 5:5; II Ccr 5:17)

QUESTIONS & ANSWERS

- (1) Acts 13:39--Why can't we be justified by the Law of Moses?

 The wages of sin is death--Romans 6:23. Therefore, the death of a human being is required. The blood of bulls and goats cannot pay for sin. A savior must pay the price.
- (2) Why does man need to be justified?

 Because man cannot have eternal life without justification.

 He will die an eternal death.
- (3) What is justification? The paying of the debt incurred by your sins.
- (4) How are we justified?

 By repenting and having faith in the Sacrifice of Christ-Romans 3:25. Repentence includes submission to God and a willingness to obey.
- (5) What is Redemption?
 Redemption is the power to buy back.
- (6) What is reconcilliation with God?
 The process of being restored to divine favor of which justification is a step. Making peace with God so he no longer cosiders you an enemy.
- Heb 10:19 Ancient Israel could only approach God in the Holy of Holies through the High Priest once a year. We, now, are able to approach God's throne any time through the process of reconcilliation & Justification by the blood of Christ.
- Heb 4:15 Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace.
- Rom 3:26 The context--Paul is talking about Justification!

 NOT whether or not the law is done away.

 Justification is through faith in the blood of

 Jesus Christ whether Jew or Gentile.
 - If the law is done away, why did Christ have to die? Romans 3:23--all have sinned!
 Romans 6:23--death penalty incurred!
 Romans 7:7---Apart from the law, there is no sin.

Rom 2:13 Doers of the law shall be justified.

Your faith will not be honored without obedience.

Jms 2:23-24 By works a man is justified, not by faith only.

If you want to continue in a justified position, you must obey--be a doer of the law. Not just "once saved, always saved" as the protestants preach!

Parakletos--Advocate, comforter

John 14:17 The hely spirit is the comforter - parakletos (also: John 14:26, I John 2:1)

I John 2:1 Advocate = comfortor, Jesus Christ can be referred to as a comfortor.

Romans 8:26-27 Jesus Christ is that spirit that makes intercession. Christ is the acting agent who speaks. He uses his holy power.

Heb 7:25 Parakletos can refer to Jesus Christ when He is in the active role.

I John 5:10 The holy spirit doesn't pray for us -- The holy spirit is the agent through which Jesus Christ works with us.

Titus 3:5-6 The holy spirit comes to us individually:
God the Father
Jesus Christ
(enabler-holy spirt-Parakletos)
Individual

The individual must have active participation (prayer). The word of God speaks to us: Jh 6:63; Matt 4:4; Jn 14:13; Acts 5:32.

I Cor 2:11 The spirit of God is the Enablber--it has to be coupled with the heart and mind of God which is the Word of God so we can understand spiritual things.

The holy spirit enables us to understand the Word of God.

God's ministry plays an vital role in our understanding -- Roman 10:14.

Zech. 1:9 We have the words of God, but the holy spirit is needed to understand it.

Jesus Christ--Author Aitios-Author-causitive agent

Hos 5:9,12 Author - causitive agent of eternal salvation Archegos - captain, premier, beginner Teleiotes - finisher

If we use the gift of the holy spirit that is in us, the work that he has started in us can be completed.

Phil 1:6 Requires active participation.

Rom 10:16-17 We must obey and participate.

Holy Spirit: Old Testarent--Ruach, Puwach--means wind, breath,

air.

New Testament--Pneuma--means mind, spirit.

can refer to: Hely--OT (Qodesh) which means sacred, dedicated,

hollowed--spirit of God.

Holy--NT (Hagios) which means holy. .

Difference between holy & sacred:

1. Holy--denotes God's active presence. God in it. God is in His word--John 6:63.

2. Sacred--Points to a higher reality. Hymns for example.

The spirit of God is HOLY

Furpose: Needed for eternal life.

Man is dust (Gen 2:7) -- man is temporal, needs the holy spirit to bridge the gap between life and death. God is spirit (Jh 4:24).

Gen. 3:22 The Tree of Life symbolized God's holy spirit. you can live forever -- to eat, you must qualify.

Power of God--holy spirit. Gen 1:2; Ps 104:30.

Acts 2:1 -a special miracle given to people who had not been converted yet. They hadn't repented or been baptized.

> God's spirit can be upon you and yet not be in you in the sense of a begettal. (John 14:17)

God's spirit convicts you (John 16:8)

Characteristics of the Holy Spirit

Acts 2:12	"Others" inquired (3,000 people were added to the Church that day - vs 41 - received Holy Spirit prior to baptism)
Acts 1:4,8	Holy spirit was promised
Acts 20:22	Should read "receive ye the holy spirit?"
Acts 21:3	"I go a fishing" they still didn't get it!
Acts 2:38	The holy spirit is a gift of God. Eternal life is a gift Jas 1:17-18.
Luke 11:13	The heavenly Father gives His holy spirit to those who ask.
Gal 5:22	The holy spirit allows us to produce fruits and through our producing God is glorified. (I Pet 1:23 being begotten of incorruptible seed) If God's seed of the holy spirit is nourished by the Word of God it will produce the fruits of the spirit. Gal 5:22 love, joy, peace, patience, gentleness, kindness, faith, temperance, goodness.
Jn 15:7	"Herein is my Father glorified, that you bare much fruit." to walk in the spirit means to walk according to the word of God.

How do you get the Holy Spirit and how do you keep it?

Chain of events leading to receiving the holy spirit:

The Father draws (Jn 6:44) Christ reveals (Lk 10:21-22; Jn 16:8) Word and Ministry (Rom 10:14-17) Repentance and Baptism (Acts 2:38) Spirit -- into one body (the Church) (I Cor 12:13)

Is the Holy Spirit "one" spirit? Is there a spirit of God and a spirit of Christ?

I Cor 12:4 Different gifts but the same spirit. I Cor 12:11 self-same spirit I Cor 13:13

For by one spirit Jn 4:24 God is spirit! Eph 3:14,15 God is a family!

(God and Christ are of the same spirit!

Jn 15:26 Spirit of truth proceeds from the Father.

Jn 17:21 How could the Father and Christ be one when Christ was in the flesh? Through the holy Spirit!!

Rom 8:9 You are in the spirit -- if the spirit of God be in you (spirit of Christ). Christ would not have spirit life if it weren't for the Father (vs 11). It is the same spirit!!

Eph 4:3,4 "one spirit" I Cor 12:13 There is one baptism (into the body of Christ). Baptisms of water, spirit and fire.

How do you maintain and increase the holy spirit?

1. Eat and drink of the Word of God -- Jn 6:63.

Matt 4:4 Man shall live by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God! David hid God's

word in his heart (Ps 119:11).

- 2. Asking, prayer and obedience -- Lk 11:13; Acts 5:32
- 3. Maintaining fellowship -- Heb 10:25.

Rom 12:5 "members one of another"

4. Fasting Helps you stay in an attitude of depending on the word of God. Humility and obedience to God.

The Church <u>is</u> the body of Christ -- and the body of Christ is not divided. How will Christ marry His own body? (Question of dissenters). We are all of the same spirit. Just as in the same way as husband and wife become one flesh. Notice Eph 5:28: He that loves his wife loves himself. We are members of His (Christ's) body. The principle emphasis is on the Church here -- not husband and wife.

Vitamin C Analogy:

Vitamin C is not stored in the body. It must be replenished each day. Vitamin C is essential for the development and retention of other essential vitamins without vitamin C, one becomes very susceptible to illness and or injury.

II Cor 4:16

The inward man must be renewed day by day.

The way that the conscience is seared with a hot iron is by failing to do what you ought to do. By not obeying God. By putting something (or someone) before God.

Will we be willing to give up all? Some are tested one way, some another. What is your god? Fornication, drunkenness, drugs, music. God asks us to rend our garments AND our hearts!! Christ is asking us to give our lives! The social, mental emotional, psychological, ego -- ALL!! Count the costs!!!

Rom 8:36

As it is written, we are killed all the day long. We are counted as sheep for the slaughter!! Does any human being have this attitude by nature? According to the word of God . . . NO! You've got to do these things (tools of spiritual growth) in order to be in the right frame of mind when the occasion to sin arises. We deserve nothing past death.

READ

When you continue to habitually do what you know you should not do, eventually your conscience will be seared. It won't matter

anymore. God's spirit will leave you.

60's

Music called "psychedelic rock". Psych = mind; delic = bending. Mind-bending or mind-twisting music. Strobe-lights, etc., etc.

I Tim 4:3

Forbidding to marry; commanding to abstain from meats.

II Tim 1:7

God's mind is a "sound mind". Not a mind caught up with trivial pursuits. For example, \$600,000 is being spent on the massive effort to save three whales. What a joke! What about relieving the suffering of humanity?! Even the "Russians" sent an icecutting ship... whatever.

Rock Music

God's music and rock music have nothing in common. KBAC will be campus-wide. Set the Example!! Let's grow past rock music. God wants perfection.

Many times students react with "who made you a ruler over the people" (pathetic).

Rom 2:21

God's name is blasphemed by us disobeying God's law. We say and teach one thing and do another.

Jn 6:63

The word of God and the spirit of God <u>are</u> equated! When you disobey God and His word, you blaspheme the Holy Spirit!!

SATAN' METHODOLOGY (CONT)
PRINCE OF THE POWER OF THE AIR:

Satan is the prince of the power of the air.

- Eph 2:1--as Prince of the power of the air, Satan is able to inject his mind into others. At what age is this allowed, can it happen? This is not known, but Mr. Armstrong SPECULATED that it began at approximately six months of age.
- Satan BROADCASTS in moods and attitudes and injects his nature and mind into man. He changes moods to cause (1) irritability, (2) melancholy, self-pity and (3) violence. Satan adds fuel to the fire and where there is no fire, he builds one.
- He can do this to me if I'm not careful. SELF-CHECK: In the past I have been corrected--did I resent it? do I still? If so, Satan adds to it.
- Rom 8:7, Jer 17:9--these are characteristic of the nature injected in to us by Satan.
- We automatically tune into Satan's wavelength by virtue of our human nature. If I choose not to tune into Satan, then I must make a concerted effort to tune into God's.
- Do I ever get in the frame of mind "'m going to stay in this frame of mind and I don't care--I'm not going to change"? If so, I am setting myself up for Satan to come in.
- Matt 5--the progressive nature of sin
 - There may be an initial breaking of a law. If I ask for forgiveness and repent, it breaks the chain of sin. If not, the following steps will follow:
 - 1--become angry--If I allow this to remain, Satan will inject resentment into my mind. (:21-22)
 - 2--raca--that person is not worth anything
 - 3--fool "moros" condemnation -- "I resent you and wish that you would die in the lake of fire."
- If I get ticked off, I should analyze whether Satan just kicked the door down. He knows us like a computer, which buttons to push, when to push them, and how hard to push.
- Root of bitterness—this can range from angry upset to total resentment—I will be thinking the laws of Satan. Satan will not leave us alone.

SATAN WORKS THROUGH HUMAN REACTION:

Eph 2:3--vanity, jealousy, lust, greed, self-centeredness--these are certain human reactions that all of us have.

- Vanity. Pride--this attitude can develop attitude toward someone that I choose not to change. BE CAREFUL! This is conducting myself in the lust of the flesh. Example of meal preparation (spent all day working on it and then the company makes a very harsh comment)--don't be resentful.
- METHODS OF SATAN (CONT): CONCENTRATED THOUGHT ON SENSITIVITY OF HUMAN SPIRIT
 - The higher the office that I may have, the more I am subject to correction.

 Also I am more subject to vanity, jealousy, lust, greed, etc...
 - Positions mean nothing unless I stay converted in it. We are made by God to be subject to vanity. Satan knows and uses this.
 - Jealousy--Gen 3:1--The seed that made Cain jealous.
 - (4:5) What caused God not to accept Cain?
 - (4:7)SIN--Cain was breaking God's laws before he brought the wrong type of offering (I Jn 3:12.
 - If I see jealousy in myself, I must ask myself "What law am I breaking?"
 - Eph 4:26--vanity, jealousy, lust, greed, self-centeredness
 - If I see a strong reaction of jealousy, ask what law...?
 - Self-centeredness--any person who deliberately practices breaking God's laws are practicing self-centeredness.

I must train my mind to have an outward concern towards others. Extent of the problem is great—most children get uptight, fight, fume, live as they wish and get mad if they don't get their own way.

SATAN IS THE GOD OF THIS WORLD:

II Cor 4:4--the god of this world identified

How is Satan the god of this world?

- Matt 12:22-30--Satan has a kingdom, with power(s) at his disposal. The blind and dumb--this doesn't mean that blind and dumb are possessed by demons, but it does give the idea that demons can cause blindness or dumbness.
- Demons have a kingdom. Even Satan cannot control his own kingdom. He has taught rebellion, and the rebellious spirit rebels against Satan.
- DON'T PLAY WITH POWER! This means demonic or God-given power
 - II Cor 11:11-3--you do not have to be spirit to be used by Satan. This is about Paul confronting false prophets. Most ministers of this world represent the kingdom of Satan.
 - The kingdom of evil can recognize the kingdom of righteousness.

- IF I DON'T USE GOD'S HOLY SPIRIT THEN ANOTHER SPIRIT WILL INFLUENCE ME.
- I DO NOT HAVE TO FEAR EVIL SPIRITS. With God's spirit or by being in the church, I have power over them.
- A demon will recognize one with an office. They will not look you in the eye. Don't fear demons--but don't delve.

SATAN CAN INFLUENCE THROUGH THE WEAKNESSES OF THE HUMAN FLESH:

- example: whenever aparticular man got drunk, he had demon problems.
- Drug use can cause demon influence or possession, i.e., woman who lost sleep for three days.
- IT IS THE MINISTER'S JOB TO BE WARY OF THE FLOCK! If he sees someone that looks tired, worn down, exhausted he should ask them how everything is going, and possibly intervene before a situation becomes out of control.
- II Co 2:6-7--state of rejection/depression, subject of demons instead of God's spirit.
- There is a point where a human must say I have sorrowed enough and put a lid on it. People in the church can help this process by comforting one another.
- II Co 2:10--I must learn to forgive when asked for forgiveness--don't give a cold shoulder to anyone. In the case of someone returning to Church, reaccept a person back into the body of Christ. If the person is not accepted but given instead a cold shoulder, Satan may be able to get through to that person--and to me if I don't accept him back into the flock.
- Satan uses this as a ploy--when someone is corrected by government, ousted then readmitted into the body of Christ, they may have the attitude "you don't like me." THIS IS IRRELEVANT! Forgiveness is not complete until you accept them back. Make them feel welcome.
- Example—woman studied for seven days then cut off her hand after reading "if your hand offend you...." Later, the demon identified himself in another man who said "I am the demon who caused the woman to cut off her hand."
- SOME DEMONS OBVIOUSLY LIKE TO GATHER THEMSELVES TOGETHER TO MAKE THEIR POWER FELT:

Mk 5:1-13--legion--we are many Lk 11:24-6--

- If there is anything that a demon wants to do, it is to humiliate one of those created in God's image.
- If a person is possessed, a minister must give fair warning that more can enter and that the end is worse than the beginning.

THE DECEPTION OF DEMONS IS THAT THEY MIX TRUTH WITH LIES.

APPEALING TO HUMAN VANITY, AS THROUGH INTELLECTUAL VANITY OR A NEW PHILOSOPHY:

The New Age Movement--a slick pantheistic philosophy.

Karma--fate or destiny

This particular movement believes there is no such thing as murder. Either (1) the deceased wanted to die, or (2) it was a case of bad karma being worked out. They also believe that God is a neutral force which can be manipulated for good or bad, that there is no transcendent all-powerful God to whom we are accountable.

Channeling--a person who acts as a channel for a demon to work through.

Harmonic convergence—everyone's spirit comes into harmony with everyone else.

Satan is the prince of the power of the air.

Jas 1:13--every man tempted when he is drawn away of his own lusts.

3 principal tempters:

Satan Society Self

3 areas of human nature that Satan appeals to:
I Jn 2:15-7--lust of the flesh, eyes, and the pride of life.
SELF is susceptible to these areas.

Sin is not as mystical and magical as it appears.

DID THE DEVIL MAKE ME DO IT?

The law of vanity is ever operant apart from God.

Conscious (5 senses) level--makes decisions--if decisions are not made above this line, then man is just a robot.

Subconscious (storehouse of memories)

conscious stream of awareness

some believe that ideas can come into the mind subliminally (below level of consciousness)

Tempters:

Satan Society

advertising

self-help, new age tapes (circumvent character building)

Placebo effect: if you think it will work, it will work--@ 70% rate of effectiveness.

Prov 23:7--as a man thinketh...

Jas 1:14--drawn away of his own lust and enticed.

Did the devil make me do it? (cont)

If a person had no protection from subliminal messages, all he would be is a robot. I could not be held accountable for something that I have no control over.

Jas 1:15--conceived--I can rationalize--I must make the decision at the CONSCIOUS LEVEL.

II Co 10:5--

If something is in the subconscious level, in order for it to be used, it must be raised into the conscious level for us to make a decision.

Prov 4:23

Is 66:2

____:__-To this man will I look--he who fears God and trembles at my word.

THE DEVIL DID NOT MAKE ME DO IT! I DID IT!

Phil 4:8--guard your mind and make it as clean as I can. Ps 119:9-11--

Cleanse my way by:

1--remove stimulus

2--change environment

KEY 3--store thee word of God in heart

Heb 10:22--done with blood of Christ when God purges sin

Eph 5:26--how Christ cleanses Church. If you want to get cleaned up, use the word of God.

Ps 119:11--word of God becomes vital to the storehouse of knowledge

Dreams--

Heb 1:1--there was a time when God worked through supernaturally inspired dreams.

Dreams are stored in the storehouse of memories. When the memories that have been stored come back to the conscious level, they become entangled--that is why dreams are often so strange.

GIVE NO CREDENCE TO DREAMS! It is one way to open yourself up to Satan's influence.

Heb 1:2--the living written word

I CAN LEAD MYSELF INTO THE STATE OF REJECTION AND DEMONIC INFLUENCE!

Is 8:20--

II Co 10:5--

OVERCOMING SATAN

Eph 6:11--the whole armor of God

- I can lose control to make sound decisions through controlled substances, vain imaginations, delving into the supernatural, physical disease...
- It is not a sin to have a dream in which I am sinning. It did not come in at the conscious level.
- Eph 2:2-3--spirit of wickedness--this does not mean possession, it means walking according to Satan's attitudes. The natural course of man is to go the way of Satan.

OVERCOMING SATAN

Satan is to be respected in that he has much power. It is made amply clear that we can overcome him. He should be rendered of none effect in our lives now. That's how we live in atonement all the days of our lives.

Eph 6:12--wicked spirits in heavenly places.

Satan has a structured government. Sometimes there are rebellions within that government. Also, God intervenes to stay the hand of Satan.

Daniel 10:1-2, 10--One of Satan's princes. Satan has princes over Gentile nations. (:20) Persian the Greco-Macedonian.

Michael--one who delivers God's people, fights for the good of God's people (Dan 12:1).

Gabriel--God's personal messenger. (Dan 921; Lk 1:19). Jude 9--Michael is the principal figure. Rev 127.

Eph 6:13--all to stand, STAND!

- (1)--protection, find him and cast him out (Jn 17:17).
- (2) -- obey God's commandments (I Jn 5:3; Ps 119:172)
- (3)--good news--be ready, willing and committed to taking the Gospel to this world
- (4)--shield of faith--able to quench all fiery darts. If I know and I know that I know, Satan will not be able to gain a stronghold. When Satan shoots his fiery darts they will be cast out.

PIVOTAL POINT -- Satan is trying to implant seeds of DESTRUCTION

Four enemies of faith (1) anxious care (Matt 6)

(2) fear (Matt 8)

(3) doubt (Matt 14)

(4) human reasoning (Matt 16)

Satan also shoots his fiery darts in the form of the LUST OF THE FLESH, LUST OF THE EYES AND THE PRIDE OF LIFE, (I Jn 2:15-7).

II Co 10:5--strongholds; James 1:15; Lust-Sin-Death Connection

(5)--Eph 5:17, I Th 5:8--HOPE is applied in practical terms by keeping the BIG PICTURE in my mind, looking to the resurrection and focused on my purpose on earth.

This is one of the main keys to spiritual survival.

- Rom 8:14-17, 18, 19-22, 24--Dr. Ward would like to be delivered from the flesh. He realizes at this point in our lives, we are not looking forward to this as he is. I must keep my mind focused on the KINGDOM OF GOD and don't let other things crowd this focus out of my mind.
- (6) -- Heb 4:12--word of God will reveal what I am deeply inside
- (7)--Put on the whole armor of God, and I will be able to stand.

NOONE SHOULD LEAVE AMBASSADOR COLLEGE WITHOUT KNOWING THAT THEY CAN OVERCOME SATAN.

- I Jn 4:4--God and Christ are greater than Satan. Christ in me is greater than Satan.
- I Jn 5:4--Faith overcomes the world. When the Holy Spirit convicts us and I move toward God, I can overcome Satan.
- I Jn 5:8-12--witnesses of the Messiahship
- Jn 16:33--We too can have that same power. I CAN OVERCOME SATAN!

CHRIST'S CONFRONTATIONS WITH SATAN

Mk 9:17--possession--demons can strike with blindness, deafness, retardation :29--putting on the whole armor

Fasting adds a new dimension to resisting Satan.

- Matt 12:43--demons in a state of torment and desire to manifest themselves. This is why ministers just don't go exorcising.
- Jas 4:7--In order to resist Satan, I must put on the whole armor of God.
- II Cc 10:4-5; Lk 11:14; Mk 9:17

- Only I can put on the whole armor of God for myself.
- Luke 11:21-2--Showing that God has the strength and power to overcome all obstacles. Even if we are doing good works, if we are not with God we are against Him.
 - Jews were trying to scatter and would not attribute anything that Christ did to God's power.

Mark 9:38

- Heb 2:14--I Jn 3:8, Jn 8:44--Satan is the author of death because he is the author of sin.
- Mark 9:44--work from the aspect of getting people to put on the armor of God so the "spiritual house" is not swept and garnished.
- It is not automatic to be able to cast out demons. Perhaps ministers of this world can cast out demons for DECEPTION.

Context

It is talking about entering into the terms of the new!! People use this chapter to say that Christ's death released us from the bonds of the Old Testament or Covenant. The context is a comparison and contrast between how one entered into the Old Covenant and how one now enters into the terms of the new. Usually the emphasis is put on the fact that Christ had to die in order enter the marriage covenant with the "Israel of God" -- The New Testament church. This, however is not the context! Again, the context is not referring to how we end the Old Covenant, but how

we enter the New.

When the Jews (Acts 21) contrived to do the law according the Old Covenant, notice that is was <u>not</u> wrong! It just was no longer necessary. The new Covenant is really built upon the Old -- there is just no need for ritualistic adherence because now we are to worship God in spirit and in truth (Jn 4:24).

FIRST COVENANT

- Ex 19:1--According to tradition, Israel entered into the Old Covenant on the day of Pentecost. @ 1470 years later, the Holy Spirit was given on the day of Pentecost.
- This was a national covenant with a provision for proselytes to be included.
- Ex 12:47--How proselytes could come in--by keeping laws and becoming circumcised. Both Israelite and proselyte were under the same law. Old covenant was a national covenant based on a set of codified laws.
- Old Covenant codified--In the Garden of Eden God made covenants verbally, i.e., Adamic Covenant, Rainbow Covenant, Abrahamic Covenant. God gave Israel His codified law to govern relationships between He and them and between themselves.
- In the Old Covenant there were about 600 laws. They could be separated into @ 3 categories:
 - (1) THE TEN COMMANDMENTS (Ex 20:1-26). Rom 7:14--commandments are spiritual and are not done away with but still exist.
 - (2) JUDEGMENT (statutes) Ex 21-24:11.
 - (3) ORDINANCES (had to do with how to approach God and how to worship). Ex 24:12-31:18 (Moses in the mountain). Most of the remainder of the books of Leviticus and Exodus are ORDINANCES. ORDINANCES are done away with in the New Covenant.



	Christ came on the scene during a transitional time between the covenants. The NT Church began in 31 A.D. and the temple was not destroyed yet. Many of the apostles spent time in the environs of the temple.
	God used Paul to write the book of Hebrews and informed the others that temple worship was no longer necessary. The temple was later destroyed in 69-70 A.D.

: 4	Cup of manna and Aaron's rod lost somewhere between the time of the Judges ad Solomon's temple. Solomon only mentions the two tables of stone.
:9	THe physical tabernacle was patterned after the heavenly.

:14	How much more shall the blood of Christ "purge your conscience" clean up the inside the heart and mind not just ceremonially clean.
10:18	There is <u>no more</u> "offering" for sin. Christ <u>is</u> the offering!!
4:16	We can enter into the holiest of holies at anytime. Not just access to God indirectly once a year through the high priest on the Day of Atonement.

What did Christ say about Judaism?

Rom 5:19

Pharisees taught doctrines of men -- not God. Mt 15:1 (Held to traditions). Don't do after their works! Mt 23:1-4 Christ said you ought to have done the 23:23 weightier matters" of the law. Christ did not do away with the law (Mt 5:17 and Is 42:21). Taught traditions of men rather than God's Mk 7:7 law. Jn 19:7 Many traditions were added to the law. Common Scriptures that supposedly do away with the law: Rom 5:12 We are not automatically sinners because of Adam. but as we sin (Rom 3:23), we automatically incur the death penalty as well! Death entered into the world through sin. Man was cut off from the spirit of God. Afterward, the pervasive spirit of the world is satan's (he was in the garden -- he is still here). Before the law was codified and given to :13 Israel sin was still in the world. But when people are ignorant of the law -- sin is not imputed. They simply die in ignorance and are later resurrected. Dead --- cut off from God! :15 Through Adam all were dead. Through Christ :17 all will live. :18 Protestants use this to say Jesus kept the law for us. Therefore, we don't have to keep This is saying that Jesus Christ lived sinlessly (righteously) Himself, qualified Him to justify us through faith. This is why He is the savior. We are to follow suite (1 Jn 2:6). The commandments are holy, righteous and 7:12 good. Commandments are righteous. The breaking of Ps 119:172 the commandments is bad -- sin. Not the law itself!! Christ qualified to be the justifier not the keeper of the law for us!

So by the obedience of one shall many be made

righteous. (Used to say "Christ did it for us"). We are <u>justified</u> by blood. Not saying we don't have to do anything ourselves.

Phil 2:8

Christ was faithful unto death. Christ learned obedience through the things He suffered. This is the obedience Paul is speaking of in Romans. Through Christ, grace abounds more than sin (Adam) but it still requires repentance!! (Rom 5:21).

Rom 10:4

Used to do away with the law! Christ is the "end" {Telos (Gk)}. Christ is the "outcome" of the law -- the end result! The law cannot make one righteous. Righteousness is by faith through Jesus Christ and the keeping of the law.

- Also inordinant observance of Holy Days, new moons and sabbaths (Col 2:16). Voluntary worship of angels (Col 2:18). Neglecting of the body (Col 2:19-23). 5.

They were saying you needed spiritual supplements. Christ's doctrine was <u>not</u> enough. There are still some in the Church who set up their own standard of "righteousness" as the Gnostics did!!

2:14	No! By blotting out the "handwriting of ordinances". The note of guilt (GK - "cheirographon tois dogmasan") This has nothing to do with nailing any law (ceremonial or spiritual) to the cross!! It is referring to the "note of guilt" that was against us!!

"Redemption of the body" (vs 23) refers to the resurrection. It is vital to maintain hope in order to cope with trials -- especially marital problems. You must realize that as long as we are in this life, things will not be "right." There will be

frustrations and injustices.

Heb 11:1 Faith is the "substance" of things hoped for...the ground or sub-

strata. What are we hoping for? Having God's very character created in us? "The evidence of things not seen..." What is the

evidence? Notice Hebrews 11:19.

Rom 4:18 "Who against hope, believed in hope?" How? Vs. 19: "Being

not weak in <u>faith</u>." That's why he had hope. Hagar and Ishmael represent working out things in the flesh. Isaac represents working out things by faith. 2. Patience Passive state? No way! Patience does not mean doing nothing.

Patience is active!

Examples: Safety -- We lock our doors

Job -- We pound the pavement

Financial

Stress -- We borrow money

Hungry -- We do whatever we can!

These are not contradictions to faith! Why is going to the doctor a contradiction of faith when you are ill? Why is healing another issue entirely. It's not! However, others <u>only</u> do what they can of and by themselves and leave God out of the picture. This is obviously not right either. It is good for a man to both hope and wait on the Eternal -- Lamentations 3:27.

3. Experience

"Dokime" means proof, testing. Lam 3:32-35 -- God has a purpose for the experiences we have -- vs 37 -- but who can do anything to us without God allowing it? No one. Believe it!!

4. Hope

Hope makes us not ashamed! We are not to be ashamed of our trials. Because the very love of God is being created in us. We are becoming God. (2 Cor 5:17) We are becoming a new creation.

5. Love

The outcome is God's very make-up: nature, mind, character, being. We must learn obedience through the things we suffer as our example, Christ, did! (Heb 5:8).

"Healed" IAOMAI -- to make whole. (the usual Greek work used for healing of disease is "THERAPEIA" from which we derive the English word therapy. "Effectual" ENERGEO -- means with energy.

"Fervent" ZELOS--hot, with zeal.

"Prayer" DEESIS--request.

Note:

This passage DOES NOT say specifically that the individual will be healed in the "Physical Sense" as the Greek word "therapeia" indicates. Therapeia is NOT mentioned in James 5:13-16.

Notice:

Matt 8:16--Christ Healed "THERAPEIA" Also: Matt 12:15

The Ministry is God's representative. Who do you seek? Generally speaking, you should be anointed first. But use common sense. You don't attempt to anoint someone while the paramedics are trying to put them on a stretcher and into an ambulance.

"If we all had the faith, everyone would be healed"--this is a common fallacy.

Being anointed and calling for the elders of the church shows that we are in submission to God's Government. We don't mind putting an arm back in the joint, but when the problem is "internal", there appears to be a contradiction of Faith involved. WHY?

Sick

"ASTHENEO" -- has a very broad meaning.

Causes

What are the causes of sickness?

Sin--Matt 9:1-6 This is not always the case (i.e. Sin=Sickness) There is no one-to-one ratio. Notice, "that you may know the Son of Man hath power to forgive Sins." These people had not entered into a covenant of sacrifice with Christ (Not: Repented, Baptized, or received the holy spirit) "...Jesus, seeing their Faith". They were convicted that Christ had the power to heal-they had seen His miracles. However, they were not in the "PROCESS" of Conversion at all. We are! I Cor 14:22 Notice: Signs and Miracles are many times for "unbelievers". Matt 9:27--Just because Christ does something one way at one time is not grounds to say he will do it the same way every time.

Remember the various dispensations:

- 1. Dispensation of Innocence
- 2. Dispensation of Conscience
- 3. Dispensation of Human Government
- 4. Dispensation of Promise
- 5. Dispensation of Law
- 6. Dispensation of Grace
- 7. Dispensation of the Fullness of Times

Again, these individuals were NOT converted. We are in the "process" of being perfected. Remember tribulation works patience, and patience works experience andLove of God. God is Love--I John 4:8,16.

NO SUCH THING AS PHYSICAL & SPIRITUAL SIN!!! I John 3:4--Sin is the transgression of the law. The law is spiritual--Romans 7:14. Therefore, sin is sin is sin!!!

- The sins of past generations are past on to the present generation--Exodus 20:5. Infants are born crippled every day. (A.I.D.E.S, Alcoholics, Sugar-Diabetes, Cancer, etc...)
- 3. Not properly Judging yourself and not properly discerning the Body of Christ (Church) -- I Cor 11 and Jms 5:16. If you do not exercise Judgement, Mercy, and Faith, you are not discerning the Body, and you will not be healed.

Passover

Three Aspects of the Lord's Body:

- 1. Christ's literal body
- 2. The Church
- 3. The Bread--Symbolizes Body and Word of God.

- I Cor 11:30 For this CAUSE many are "Sick"--ASTHENEO and many are asleep (dead).
 - :32 Notice: When we are Judged, we are chastened of the Lord. We should judge ourselves therefore, and pray diligently for one another.

The Corinthians were not doing this...Therefore, (vs.30), God stepped in and Chastened them. Many were sick and dead. Why? Because God hates us-NO! Because he wants us to enter His Kingdom.

1 + 1 = 3 makes a marriage! Man, Woman, & God form a divine union.

It is important for both people to grow spiritually and intellectually. If only one person grows, they may become incompatible.

Eph 5:22 "Submit" also carries the meaning of "adapt". Adapt yourself to your own husband.

Don't allow anyone to tamper with your relationship once you're engaged. Before you're engaged, that's the "fact-finding" time.

God's "Basics" for a marriage relationship:

- 1. Love
- 2. Respect
- 3. Fidelity
- 4. Biblical laws re: Relationships

Within God's basic guidelines, you can build your marriage anyway you want to.

For Example: Who will pay the bills--keep track of the budget?
Who will do what around the house?
Who will make the decisions? (both should).

Gen 2:18 Marriage is honorable--God made it that way. A "help" is in a <u>support</u> role.

Be careful in of clinging--too much affection may drive him away. You can and should be "jealous" for your husband in a Godly way...if you see/perceive wrong intentions in someone. You should gently point it out.

A man should dominate, but not domineer. He should be the leader.

The man, as a leader, should communicate to his wife many things...what you like or dislike, what irritates you, etc. Let her know how far she can go in "debating" issues, etc.

Marry the person you love!! You should be attracted to them, love to

Take time to get to know the person--how they act/react to situations. If a man is too picky in telling his wife how to do certain everyday things, his wife will be discouraged.

- Eph 5:25 "husbands, love your wives..."

 Man should make woman feel this love. Make her special. And make her feel special. Prize her.
- I Pet 3:7 A man should have knowledge about the woman he wants to marry--takes time together.

There are only two reasons for Divorce: (I Cor 7:11-12; 27-28)

From the beginning it was NOT so. One wife, not many! (does not matter what society allows polygamy and bigamy are out!)
Paul was single (notice verse 29) "the time is short" Paul was expecting the return of Christ in his day. Instructions up front are "make the marriage work!" For instance: wife-abuse or child-abuse. The Church will try to reconcile, but will allow separation for a while. Must remain inmarried though.
Believer who leaves the Church, and is not pleased to dwell. Disfellowshipment or leaving the Church is NOT grounds for divorce. It comes down to the are of being "pleased to dwell".

"Pleased to Dwell" is not what comes out of their mouth, but by their fruits--actions. Each case must be dealt with individually. Final decision comes from headquarters however. Report is sent in by both parties (if they are in the Church), or whichever member is in the Church. Also, the local Pastor sends in a report from evaluations.

Types of behavior or actions that show one is NOT "pleased to dwell": Abusive, Sexually promiscuous, Financially unreliable, etc...

If a mate commits adultery, and truly repents of his/her sin, the mate who did not commit adultery is bound by Matt. 6:15 to forgive the transgression.

-- Current Administrative Decision--

If a husband and wife divorce because they were not pleased to dwell for whatever reason, and one partner leaves the Church, the other partner is free to remarry. Later, if the individual who left the Church, repents and returns to services, he is also able to remarry. If both parties do not remarry during their separation, they could even remarry each other once both are back in the Church.

I Cor 7:24

Married conditions are concluded

:25 Singles are discussed.

Paul simply says that you can serve God with greater singleness of purpose when you are in an unmarried state. He is not trying to give anyone a guilt-trip.

- Switches gears: This has nothing to do with a Father controlling his daughter. This is the proper reading of the verse from the Greek--"If anyone thinks HE behaves unseemly to HIS virginity..." (read the context). In other words, the flame is not getting any weaker. "Let them marry". (if he/she cannot maintain his/her virginity).
- If he/she can maintain his/her will-power, than let him/her remain single.
- It's not sin either way, but under the "Present Distress", it is better to remain unmarried.
- A baptized member may only marry a baptized member. Free to be married only "in the Lord". (remember vs. 15 when reading the first half of vs. 39) The wife is bound to the husband as long as he lives--exception is verse 15, if he/she departs the Marriage.

Adultery is a national sin at this time. Even civil laws of the land recognize certain responsibilities that people are bound to once they begin to share the intimacies of marriage.
Ceremony	"Do you covenant with God & Man?" There are spiritual implications to entering into a covenant agreement with someone else.
Problems	Two Principal Problems in the Church with regard to marriage: 1. Understanding the Purpose of Marriage 2. Government: Administration of Authority and Submission to authority.



Not until the 20th Century did people begin to reverse the order of love and marriage. Marriages were arranged! And marriage sustains love, not love sustaining marriage.

There should be physical and psychological attraction, but that is not all that is needed to sustain a happy marriage. The two of you must understand the purpose of marriage.

God -- Family



Must

Understand "who" God is. "What" He is doing. Understand "who" man is. "What" man's purpose is. (God Reproducing Himself). "What" the purpose of marriage and family is (adding to the family of God). Marriage is God ordained! God sets the conditions for marriage. True love will never be achieved unless the two of you meet God's conditions. Marriage was designed to be an overwhelming success!!! The pinnacles of Human sensation can be "lawfully" expressed in marriage.

Of all the things in the physical creation, "Marriage" is the principal way we understand what God is doing!

Laws are constituted (established) by God.

Tyranny (Dictatorship) is the precursor of revolution. Revolution is the precursor of anarchy. Anarchy is the precursor of tyranny. All the "isms" fall in between--(ie. Socialism, Communism, Republicanism, etc...).

MARRIAGE AND FAMILY

Fourteen concepts have been emphasized and stated in conceptual form thus far. They are all directed toward understanding marriage and family.

- 1. Understand who God is, what He is, and what He is doing, what His purpose is.
- 2. Understand who man is, what man is, and the purpose of human existence. Man apart from God is just a physical, chemical and temporary existence.
- 3. Understand that God is reproducing Himself.
- 4. Understand the purpose and plan for marriage and family. (Closely related to #3.)
- 5. Understand the ultimate purpose of marriage and family is to add to the family of God.
- 6. Keep the big picture in full focus. What is the big picture? It's all of the preceding. It's keeping the first five in focus, mind.
- 7. Marriage is God ordained. Marriage is a covenant with God and man.
- 8. Since God created male and female, and ordained the marriage covenant, He has the right to set the conditions.
- 9. Marriage was designed to be an overwhelming success.
- 10. Marriage is a physical union but a divine institution.
- 11. Marriage parallels what God is doing in bringing many sons to glory, thus it allows us to understand the plan of God.
- 12. The marriage relationship is designed to enhance life and all dimensions of life. The basic dimensions of life are spiritual, mental, psychological, social, emotional and physical.
- 13. Male and female have the same potential but have been assigned different roles in the family structure.
- 14. In Christ and in the resurrection, there is neither male nor female.

Authority in Marriage

Authority is one of 20th century man's Big Hang-ups. Existentialism--"I can do whatever I want as long as it doesn't hurt anyone else." The logical fallacy of Existentialism is that the perpetrators of the actions determine what does and does not "Hurt" others. Existentialism therefore, takes away the freedom of others. It does not "give" freedom! Ironically, Existentialism hides behind the First Amendment.

We learn method not content. We are heavily influenced by our environment. Paul said, "A little leaven leavens the whole lump." We have seen "great" abuses of authority in the 20th Century: Adolf Hitler, Fidel Castro, the Iyatolla etc...

There is a tremendous lack of consistency in administering authority which breeds rebellion and anxiety.

Marriage is NOT a Master/Slave relationship!

Feelings

Jeremiah 17:9--You cannot administer authority by your feelings. 20th Century man has a problem not only with submitting to authority but also administering it.

Satan Isa 14:4 Satan is a Tyrant

The Oppressor, the Exacter!

"The standard of living is dropping all over the world."--John Goddard. This was the single greatest observation of his world travels. The Space between the "Haves" and the "Have Nots" is increasing with each passing moment.

"He that ruled the nations in anger" referring to none other than Satan.

Satan will be brought down to the pit. Satan would have <u>YOU</u> to be a prisoner--a Tyrant as he himself is.

A root of bitterness will destroy you! People who get in the frame of mind that the "church has hurt me" are on their way out toward a root of bitterness as well as out of the Church. Marriage is much the same, "He hurt me!" or "She hurt me!" If you dwell on this, whether it's true or not, a root of bitterness will take root and you will perish if not repented of quickly.

3. Colossians 3:17-23--Realize you both serve Christ. Do not be bitter toward each other. If a Husband or Wife does not repent after you do, and confess their fault, but instead, use your

repentance as a means to justify their actions, then you must not lecture them. True repentance does not have ulterior motives. You repent regardless of whether or not the other party does. Watch how you act toward your mate at home and in public.

Many men are loving, kind and gentle (on their best behavior) during the courtship period. But it's a different story after marriage. It would be better to "injure" outside the home than nside.

Husbands must both "bring home the bacon" and be the "teacher" in the home. In today's world, the moral/intellectual responsibilities have been turned over to the women.

In Marriage:

Women do not violate scripture if they go to their husbands when something is offending them. Nevertheless, the husband is the spiritual leader.

I the wife being mistreated, she is not bound to sit there and be beaten or abused. She does have other recourse:

- 1. Go to husband first -- confront it
- 2. If can't reconcile -- take it to ministry

Generally the woman brings it to the ministry. However, it is the responsibility of the husband as the leader to take it to the ministry but usually they don't. Then the woman needs to.

Don't allow the situation to make you become bitter! Follow reconciliation scriptures.

In Employment (in church):

Supervisor (a minister) treating you wrongly.

- 1. Go to that person, approach with correct attitude. Remember, "Who will I obey? God or man?" Most often we obey men. We need to fear God.
- 2. If necessary, take someone with you, usually another minister.



Joshua	Joshua was loyal to God and taught the people God's laws. After Israel was settled in the land, God wanted them to look to Him as their King. That is why God appointed no one to replace Joshuano one to sit in the seat of Moses. Priests, on the other hand, were still God's messengers.
Judges 21:25	There was no King in Israel, and every man did what was right in his own eyes. "Because iniquity abounds, the love of many shall wax cold." Humans have a tendency to pattern the behavior of other men. The question is "How does God see your behavior?"
I Sam 8:1-5	"They have not rejected you, they have rejected Me." The iniquity of the sons of Samuel was no excuse for the people to reject God as their King!
I Sam 10:27	"How can this man save us?" (referring to the newly appointed Saul)Rebels. There have always been people who resist those that <u>God</u> places in office. God, however, expects loyalty to those He puts in office. Before Saul had done good or evilbefore he had done anything, there were those who said in effect, "Who is <u>he?</u> "
Matt 23:3	God does not expect you to be obedient to sinin the case of a rebellious leader. "Whatever they tell you, do! But do not do according to their works!"

After David was anointed King over Israel, Saul tried to kill him

repeatedly, but David remained loyal to Saul nevertheless.

I Sam 16:13

Summary

- -Sometimes He does it Himself.
- -Sometimes He has others do it.
- 2. God backs up those He selects to fill an office.
- 3. Our ultimate loyalty is to God!

Acts 1:15-23

God used the method of "drawing lots" to select a replacement for Judas. The Apostles proposed two candidates: Joseph (Barabus) and Mathias. But notice verse 24 -- "O Lord,...show which of the two You have chosen."

Acts 5:1

Ananias & Sapphira did not recognize the apostle's authority to gather from the people and distribute as needs be.

Acts 4:36-37

Barabus, on the other hand, did recognize their authority to do so.

Ananias and Sapphira wanted to test that authority. Their approach was "I wonder if anything will happen if we don't give all." They kept back part of their proceeds just to see what would happen. If one of God's representatives is asking you a direct question, you had better be careful how you answer. Do not lie or try to deceive. God is not mocked! He will judge. You may not be struck down as Ananias and Sapphira were, but you will be judged.

Acts 5:13

"Yet none dared join them, (or try to be equal with the apostles in authority) but the people esteemed them highly." God with back those He places in authority.

This doctrine of God's Government and God's authority will see you through some very difficult times if you understand it. God is in charge. The history of Israel and God's people is littered with disloyalty. See that you are not swept away by it!!

Always remember, the body of Christ is <u>not</u> divided. God and Christ love the Church above all things!! Christ gave Himself for it and God gave the life of His only begotten Son for it.

God uses men to teach us, but He does not take away personal responsibility to prove the truth and remain faithful to it! (see Acts 17:11--example of the Bareans).

Our Responsibility to God never changes!! Does God <u>ever</u> say, "Rise up against those I either placed over you or those I allow to be placed over you?" The resounding answer is, "No!"

Resisting

Says God is incapable of caring for the Church.

- 1. You Deny God and Christ's authority.
- 2. You Deny the authority of the one appointed by God.
- 3. You Deny the scriptures which tell you to grow in grace and knowledge.

Conclusion

Often, the principal motive for rebellion against authority is an intense desire to be a teacher or minister in the Church. And if God won't give them the platform, they'll seize it themselves through flattery, deceit, sowing discord, open-rebellion, or whatever it takes. Problem is...it takes God, and God is on the side of those He appoints--not those who appoint themselves!

The Book of I Corinthians is an excellent reference in this regard.

Great rhetorical question of the entire epistle: "Is Christ Divided?" And Paul goes on to show that not only is Christ NOT divided, but neither is the body--the Church of God.

I Cor 10:1

How is it possible for ALL to speak the same thing?

-God's Word -God's Spirit

-Teachers of the Word (Headquarters & Apostle)

There must be someone who makes the "final" decision with regard to Doctrinal matters.

Overview of I Corinthians

Problems:

<u>Chapter 1</u> "favorite ministers". Paul points out the fact that you are in the Church because of God and Christ. Men were simply used as instruments to help you come to understand. You are in the Church because <u>God</u> called you-Not because of any man or human intellect. (vs.30)

<u>Chapter 2</u> Brethren lacked the Mind of Christ.

Chapter 3 Their fleshly mind was still predominating--"Are you not still carnal?" God gives the increase--Not any of the ministry (vs.6). Let no many glory in men (vs.21).

<u>Chapter 4</u> Brethren were judging Paul. "He that judges me is the Lord." They were puffed up concerning Paul's visit.

<u>Chapter 5</u> Not being their brother's keeper. Brethren allowed incestuous fornicator to remain among them.

<u>Chapter 6</u> Brethren were taking their brother to court in the courts of the world.

<u>Chapter 7</u> Brethren misunderstood divorce & remarriage. Also misunderstood circumcision.

<u>Chapter 8</u> Brethren were divided over meat offered to idols. If your actions divide the body of Christ, then do not do them (even if it is lawful to do them). People have a tendency to take "their" liberty and understanding and cram it down other's throats through their actions.

<u>Chapter 9</u> Brethren questioned Paul's apostleship because he did not require tithes of them. (or take a wife) He had the power to do both if he desired.

<u>Chapter 10</u> Paul warns the Church not to fall prey to the same sins as the Church in the Wilderness. Once again, he enforces the "oneness" of Christ's body--Bread and Cup is our communion in Christ.

Chapter 11 Brethren were taking the Passover unworthily.

<u>Chapter 12</u> Brethren were without understanding with regard to spiritual gifts.

Chapter 13 More excellent way is expounded--Love!

<u>Chapter 14</u> All things should be done to edify the Church. Brethren did not understand the use of "tongues". God is not the author of confusion (vs.33).

<u>Chapter 15</u> Some of the Brethren went so far as to deny the resurrection.

<u>Chapter 16</u> Paul exhorts the Brethren regarding an offering. "Let any man who does not love Christ be accursed!" (vs.22).

conclusion:

From your "calling" to the "resurrection", Christ is NOT divided!!!

"God has set some in the Church..." Government offices as well as spiritual gifts.

Eph 1:

Doctrinal emphasis is Christ as Head of the Church. We are to hold fast to Him and He will give us the strength we need to do so (vs.22).

4:11-16 "For shep!

"For the perfecting of the saints." The ministry is God's tool to shepherd His sheep. So we may be perfectly joined together. It is <u>not</u> "them" and "us". We are <u>not</u> to be alienated from

government! To be alienated from government is to be alienated from God.

Roles of Govt.

Apostle must set Doctrine: I Cor 7--Divorce & Remarriage; I Cor 8--Meat offered to Idols; I Cor 11--Passover; I Cor 12--Spiritual Gifts. Paul gave instruction on "principles" and not always through direct scriptural reference (see I Cor 7:6).

Apostle must lay the Foundation: I Cor 3:10; Eph 2:20. Ministry follows-up on the apostle's teaching-I Cor 3:6. People want to know who the "greatest" is. Apostles are responsible for fathering people in the Gospel.

Apostle must Administer Government in the Church: I Cor 5:1-7-Paul judged the Incestuous Fornicator. As long as a person has an audience of sympathizers, they will continue in Sin. The people that march on Washington to save "tomcats" are the same ones that march in favor of "abortion"!

I Cor 5:6

"A little leaven leavens the whole lump"

Apostle must Administer Civil Government: I Cor 6--Take disputes to the Church--Not outside the Church!

Apostle must take Tithes: I Cor 9--Ministry is to be supported financially by the brethren.

2. <u>Marked Disfellowship</u>--Those which cause division or offenses contrary to the Doctrine of Christ (Proselytizing of brethren). See: Romans 16:17-18.

Warning

Ministers today are held liable for just about everything they say. Many have been sued! We should pray "God protect me from my enemies and those who lie in wait."

I Jn 5:16

This is an obscure scripture that we do not fully understand at the present time. The question arises however, "When do we stop praying for them?"

When an offense occurs:

- 1. Go alone to him/her
- 2. Take a witness
- 3. Take it to the Church
- 4. Judgement
- 5. Treat as sinner & publican

We teach that the "unpardonable sin" is the sin that is not repented of. However, when do we determine how long is allowed before the person can repent. (example: some have been restored after being out of the Church for 20 years or more). Answer: We don't determine! God does (thankfully).

Eventually, a person's fruits will begin to show their total rejection of God and His teaching. We <u>are not</u> clear as to the exact time when we should not pray for an individual any longer.

You should start with the "individual" in the case of an offense. This procedure depends on the severity of the problem however. Their are times (rare times) when the problem should be addressed by someone higher in authority.

Subject

Messages to the Seven Churches

- 1. The message was given to 7 literal churches on a church route.
- 2. The message represents the eras of the Church of God.
- 3. The message is applicable for all times. "He who has an ear to hear, let him hear what the spirit says to the Churches."

7 Stars = 7 Angels (aggelos)
Messenger or Angel (human or spirit)

Messenger

Hebrew = Malak Greek = Aggelos (Man or Angel)

Malachi

- 5 Messengers of the Book of Malachi
- 1. Prophets (I Pet 1:10-12) prophets prophesied of a church to come.
- 2. Priests (Mal 2:7)
- 3. John the Baptist (Mal 3:1)
- 4. Jesus Christ--Messenger of the covenant
- 5. Elijah to come (Mal 4:5)

Rev 1:1

Chain of Revelation:

God --- Christ --- Aggelos --- John --- 7 Aggelos (Would it make sense for John to give the message/letter back to an angel?)
Obviously not! John gave the letters to the Pastors of the seven churches to be read to the congregations--Notice: Colossians 4:12-18.

"aggelos"--the last meaning listed in <u>Strong's Concordance</u> is "pastor".

God and Christ, through Mr. Armstrong, laid the foundation for the Philadelphian Era. Mr. Tkach is NOW the principal messenger to the Philadelphian Era of God's Church.

Rev 3:7

What is the "Key of David"? It is Ruling and Reigning with Christ in the Kingdom of God. God restored Church Government through Mr. Armstrong to the Philadelphian Church.

Ephesus - c. 31-130's

Characteristics of Jesus:

- Holds the seven stars (angels) in his right hand
- Walks in the midst of the seven golden candlesticks (seven churches)

Commendation:

- 1. Know thy works, labour, patience
- 2. Cannot bear them which are evil---you have tried them which say they are apostles, and are not, and have found them liars
- Have borne, have patience, and for my name's sake have laboured
- You have not fainted
- 5. You hate the deeds of the Nicolaitans (more sin = more grace)

What is wrong:

1. Left first love (Jesus Christ)

Type of Punishment:

1. Remove candlestick out of its place, except you repent

Command:

- 1. Repent and do the first works (love, mercy, judgment, and faith)
- He that has an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

Reward:

1. I will come unto you quickly and remove candlestick unless you repent

He who overcomes will be given to eat of the tree of life, which is in the midst of the paradise of God

Smyrna - c. 130's-330's

Characteristics of Jesus:

- 1. The first and the last
- 2. Was dead and is alive

Commendation:

- 1. Know your works, and tribulation, and poverty (but you are rich) -- they were rich spiritually
- 2. Knows they are being persecuted by those who say they are Jews, but are of the synagogue of Satan

What is wrong:

Type of Punishment:

Command:

- 1. Fear none of those things which you shall suffer a. cast into prison that you be tried (the devil <u>SHALL</u> cast) b. tribulation for ten days
- 2. Be faithful unto death
- 3. He that hath an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches (plural)

When:

1. After ten days of tribulation (implied) you will be rewarded

Reward:

- 1. Faithful unto death, and I will give you a crown of life
- 2. He that overcomes shall not be hurt by second death

Revelation 13:16 "And he (Antichrist) caused all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and bond, to receive a mark in their right hand, or in their foreheads..."---this is a name known and given to man by man (Antichrist). The name Christ gives---no man knows. Receive mark by worshipping beast - Revelation 14:9; Revelation 13:15.

Characteristics of Jesus:

1. Has the sharp sword with two edges (the word of God)

Commendation:

- 1. Know your works:
 - a. Dwell where Satan's seat is (Satan's seat = Satan's throne) (Rev. 13:2, II Thes. 2:4)
 - b. You hold fast my name (the Church of God) implied
 - c. You have not denied my faith (II Tim. 2:12)
 - d. You were faithful (even in those days) = times past (implied) when Antipas was slain among you. (Antipas = antipater = against father = those who try to set themselves up in place of God who is our father in the spiritual sense. Antipater could be a generic term for all of those who were martyred during THOSE days one man would have been killed in one day.)

What is wrong:

- 1. You have those who hold the doctrine of Balaam (spiritual fornication)
 - a. eat things sacrificed to idols
 - b. commit fornication
- 2. You have those who hold the doctrine of the Nicolaitans

Type of Punishment:

1. Will fight against them with the sword of my mouth (Rev. 19:15)

Command:

- 1. Repent
- 2. He that has an ear to hear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

1. Repent; or I will come unto you quickly and fight against you with the sword of my mouth

- 1. He that overcomes will be given to eat of the hidden manna (Jesus Christ
- 2. Give him a white stone (signifies approval) in the stone will be written a new name which no man knows except he that receives it. The white stone symbolically is the head of the resurrected Christian (Rev. 3:12 "I will write upon him the name of my God...") (John 1:42 "...you shall be called Cephas which is by interpretation, a stone.") (Mt. 16:18 Christ built church on a big rock or stone) (Mt. 21:42 "the stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing and it is marvellous in our eyes") Christ is the stone or rock we will have his name written on us. (Rev. 14:1 "...having his Father's name written in their foreheads.") (The clinching proof is Rev. 22:4 "...his name shall be in their foreheads.") Contrast Rev. 13:16

Thyatira - c. 1000-1500

Characteristics of Jesus:

- 1. Eyes like unto a flame of fire
- 2. Feet like fine brass
- 3. Searches the reins and hearts and give to every one according to their works

Commendation:

- 1. Know your works, and charity, and service, and faith, and patience
- 2. Last works to be more than the first works

What is wrong:

- 1. Permit Jezebel (a false religious teacher) to teach and seduce church members to commit fornication (get involved with world's system -James 4:4)
- 2. Eat things sacrificed to idols
- 3. Gave her time to repent and she did not

Type of Punishment:

- 1. Cast her into a bed (literal place or position of reclining) in other words God will place this woman in a position that will make it very easy for her to influence others or it will be easy for this woman to commit spiritual fornication with the world.
- Kill her children with death (those children = churches who go and commit spiritual fornication with her)
- Spiritual fornication with this woman leads to being cast into great tribulation and hence being killed as stated above (indicates that Thyatira still in existence at time of end)

Command:

- That which you have hold fast till I come (Those who do not hold the doctrine of the woman, and have not known the depths of Satan, as they speak; I will put upon you none other burden.) Depths of Satan are described in II Tim. 3:1-8, 13, I Tim. 4:1-3, II Tim. 2:17-18. The word of God is your defense II Tim. 3:14-4:5. James 1:19, John 6:63, II Thes. 2:10-12
- Overcome and keep my works unto the end
- 3. He that has an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

1. Hold fast till I come

- 1. Those who resist Jezebel's teachings will have none other burden cast on them (other than having to really resist the temptation of James 4:4 - implied)
- 2. Power over the nations, rule with Christ as He received rule from His Father (Note nations to be broken into shivers by the stone Dan. 2:34
- 3. Give him the morning star or Jesus Christ or literally you will be resurrected Rev. 22:16

Sardis - c. 1500-1900's

Characteristics of Jesus:

- 1. Has the seven spirits or the spirit to each church or the holy spirit Rev. 1:4, 4:5
- 2. Has the seven stars

Commendation:

What is wrong:

- You have a name that you are alive, but you are about to die (implied since verse 2 says - "...strengthen the things which are ready to die.")
- 2. Few names even in Sardis which have not defiled their garments
- 3. Your works are not perfect before God

Type of Punishment:

 Come as a thief and you will not know what hour I will come upon you - unless you watch

Command:

- 1. Be watchful, and strengthen the things which remain
- 2. Remember how you have received and heard, and hold fast, and repent (Go back to basic doctrines since your works are not perfect - implied since verse 2 says your works are not perfect before God - then verse 3 says therefore - because your works are not perfect remember the basics and perfection is one of the doctrines of the Church of God Heb. 6:1-2
- 3. He that hath an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

 Unless you watch I will come on you as a thief and you will not know the hour

- 1. Walk with me in white (he who overcomes will receive the rewards)
- 2. Clothed in white raiment
- 3. Will not blot out his name out of the book of life
- 4. Confess his name before my Father, and his angels (Luke 12:8)

Philadelphia - c. 1933-Present

Characteristics of Jesus:

- 1. He is holy, true
- He has the key of David, opens and no man shuts, shuts and no man opens (Isa. 22:22)

Commendation:

- Know your works, I have set before you an open door and no man can
- Have a little strength = "dunamis" in Greek = power of a supernatural
- Kept my word
- Have not denied my name

What is wrong:

Type of Punishment:

Command:

- Hold that fast which you have, that no man take your crown
- He that has an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

I come quickly

- Because you have kept the word of my patience, you will be protected from the great tribulation
- I will make the synagogue of Satan those who say they are Jews and are not - do lie - implies deliberate lying - they will come and worship before your feet and will make them know that He has loved you
- Him that overcomes will I make a pillar (those who uphold) in the temple of my God, and he shall go no more out - Ps. 23:6, Heb. 13:14
- Write upon him the name of my God, and the name of the city of my God, which is new Jerusalem which comes down out of heaven from my God.
- 5. And I will write upon him My new name

Laodicea - Future

Characteristics of Jesus:

1. The Amen, the faithful and true witness, the beginning of the creation of God

Commendation:

What is wrong:

- You are neither hot or cold (I would you were hot or cold)
- You are self righteous you think you are rich spiritually or because you say

Type of Punishment:

- Spue you out of my mouth = I will vomit you out of my mouth because you are lukewarm. See II Tim. 3:1-8
- 2. Because you say that you are rich and increased with goods, and have need of nothing; and know not that you art wretched, and miserable and poor, and blind, and naked (see John 12:39-41) I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that you may be rich; and white raiment, that you may be clothed, that the shame of your nakedness do not appear; and anoint thy eyes with eyesalve, that you may see (the Laodiceans are filled with self righteousness)
- 3. As many as God loves he rebukes and chastens

Command:

- 1. Be zealous and repent
- 2. He that hath an ear let him hear what the spirit says to the churches

When:

I stand at the door and knock = the time is now

- If any man hear my voice, and open the door, I will come in to him, and will sup with him, and he with me. (Jesus Christ will live in us if we quench not the spirit) (Note this is more of a statement of the position of Jesus Christ with regard to all of the Churches than it is a reward to Laodicea)
- 2. To him who overcomes will I grant to sit with me in my throne even as I also overcame, and am set down with my Father in his throne

Doctrines May 4, 1989 Lecture #52

Subject	Seven	Church	Eras

Reference to the handout of messages to the 7 churches. (additional comments below)

Ephesus Doctrine of the Nicolaitans--from secular evidence, appears to be the anti-nomion of the Gnostic sect. "Sin so that grace may abound." Doctrine to sin all you wish.

Pergamos Doctrine of Baalim--doing what you do for hire, or doing what you do for gain (personal advantage).

Philadelphia Have "little strength"--DUNAMIS (Gk) means miracle working power. We, therefore, have little miracle working power.

Laodicea Emphasis with regard to offenses is more on their self-righteousness than it is on being lukewarm. They say, "We are rich and increased with goods and have need of nothing."--rather bold statement (proud of their stance).

Question Who gets what reward? Does each church only receive the reward listed under their address or are the rewards a composite of what every resurrected saint will receive?

Answer By reading each reward listed and noting the prophetic time sequence involved, you can easily determine which rewards are universal and which are specific in nature.

Isa 2:3-4 If you want to specify reward, it would appear that #3 reward for Philadelphia refers to "making" the law as opposed to "executing" the law.

Specificity Only occurs in the messages to the Philadelphian and Laodicean churches. "Pillars in the temple of God"--Philadelphia. "Sit with God on His throne"--Laodicea.

Question In the message to Ephesus, what does the removing of the candlestick represent?

Answer The quenching of God's holy spirit and the fire going out. God's spirit presence being removed.

I Cor 10:20 Sincerity is <u>not</u> the test of whether or not God is present. Many are sincerely wrong! The Bible points out very clearly that God's way is not mixed with any other.

Subject What will the Church be doing at the end of the age?

18 Truths restored to the Church.

If you could summarize in one word what God restored through Mr. Armstrong, it would be "LAW".

Weightier
Judgement, Mercy, and Faith (Matthew 23:23) all
spring from the law. People try to jump from one
to another. It's a package! If the law is of no
effect, why, pray tell, do you need grace? There's
no offense without a law. We are saved by GRACE
however (Ephesians 2:8-10).

Eph 3:2 We are in the administration of Grace even now! Mal 4:4 "Remember you the law of Moses..."

Mal 4:5-5

1. Church will be preparing a people for the return of Christ (doing the work of Elijah). Under Mr. Tkach's administration, the emphasis has clearly shifted to "individual application" of the law.

Matt 28:19-20 2. Church will be preaching the gospel to the world as a witness:

--362 T.V. Stations Worldwide

--262 T.V. Stations Domestically (U.S.)

--45 Million pieces of mail send out in the first 2 months of 1989 alone.

--5.8 Million subscribers to the Plain Truth Magazine.

I Pet 5:3 3. Church will be feeding the Flock

John 17:12 4. Church will be keeping the Name of God.

II Pet 3:18 5. Church will be growing in the grace and knowledge of Jesus Christ.

Rev 3:11 Some misapply this scripture to say that we are to simply "sit" on that truth that has been revealed to us. Notice: I Cor 13:12. Even in the Biological world, nothing remains stagnant!! We are told in the Bible in Ps 90:12 to "Teach me to number my days..."

I Cor 5:17 6. Church will understand how God's character is created within us. (also: Romans 5:3-5)

John 14:15 7. Church will be keeping God's Commandments. (also: John 15:10; I Cor 7:19; Rev 12:17)

- Ex 31/Lev 23 8. Church will be keeping the Sabbath and Holy Days which are a sign and help us to understand the plan of God.
- I Cor 5 & 6 9. Church will be administering the government of God in the Church of God in the end of the age--both spiritual govt. and civil govt.
 - 11. Church will know and understand the modern identity of Israel.
 - 12. Church will understand prophecy sufficiently to warn the nations.
 - 13. Church will be administering God's Government in the Home as well.
