# Hangging Holy Day Picture Calender



## Materials needed

Large cardboard roll  
Yarn  
Long piece of shelf paper  
Wood dowel  
Scissors, glue, markers

## Instructions

1. After all of the Holy Day pictures have been colored, have the children cut them out in 6"X9" rectangles.
2. Cut a piece of shelf paper long enough for 8 pictures to fit on with space between them for border and words.
3. Glue pictures to shelf paper. Overlap ends of shelf paper and glue together. Hang paper over cardboard roll. Put wood dowel inside cardboard roll. Tie yarn to wood dowel ends to form hanger.
4. Hang on wall. Turn according to Holy Day season.

## Craft
