### PURPOSES AND GOALS OF BIBLE BOWL

The game "Bible Bowl" was designed with the idea of providing good fun and fellowship for the young people in the Church, while at the same time acting as a vehicle for expanding their knowledge and understanding of the Word of God.

The structure of the game allows both participants and audience to test their Bible knowledge, their mental alertness and their ability to think quickly under the pressure of the game situation.

All of these ingredients add up to an exceptional teaching aid by which we can all improve our Bible knowledge.

#### BIBLE BOWL RULES

- Each team consists of a panel of four players for a game.
   A team may switch players between games, but NOT during a game.
- 2. The game begins when the moderator asks the first question.
- 3. Any player on either team may elect to answer the question by pressing the button in front of him, lighting "his" light. As soon as one button is pushed, it automatically inactivates all other buttons. That individual must then, on his own, answer the question. If he answers it correctly his team scores five points. If he fails to answer within five seconds, or if he answers incorrectly, the other team is given the opportunity to answer. This team can confer for five seconds and then one player must give the answer.
- 4. After a team member has <u>correctly</u> answered three questions in a row, he is not allowed to answer any additional questions until another team member has correctly answered a question.
- 5. Each game lasts for five minutes. The clock should be started when the moderator asks the first question, and should be left running throughout the game.
